The Swedish grading

International scale

A

(Excellent)

B

(Very good, with few errors)

E

(Good, with some errors. This is the minimum passing grade)

F

(Fail)

In some cases, specific courses are graded using two grades: **G - Godkänd (pass)** or **U - Underkänd (Fail)**

The most common grade point scale at Swedish universities and colleges ranges from a maximum grade point of 5 to a minimum passing grade of 3.

The Italian grading system

International scale	Italian scale
A (Excellent)	30 (Eccellente)
B (Very good, with few errors)	29 - 30 (Ottimo)
C (Good, with some errors)	27 - 28 (Buono)
D (Satisfactory, with many errors)	24 - 26 (Abbastanza buono)
E (Sufficient)	18 - 23 (Sufficiente)
F (Fail)	< 17 - Respinto

At upper secondary school, grades follow an assessment scale with a minimum grade point of 60 to a maximum of 100.



The Hungarian grading system

International scale	Hungarian scale
A (excellent)	5
B (very good, with few errors)	4
C (good, with some errors)	3
D (satisfactory, with many errors)	2
E (sufficient. This is the minimum passing grade)	2

A grade point of 1 is considered as failed.

Institutions may also apply either a three-grade scale (5 (excellent) / 3 (satisfactory) / 1 (fail)) or any other grading system as long as it can be compared with the others.



The Danish grading system

Grade	Description	ECTS	Old scale (00-13)
12	For an excellent performance displaying a high level of command of all aspects of the relevant material, with no or only a few minor weaknesses.	A	13 11
10	For a very good performance displaying a high level of command of most aspects of the relevant material, with only minor weaknesses.	B	10
7	For a good performance displaying good command of the relevant material but also some weaknesses.	C	9 8
4	For a fair performance displaying some command of the relevant material but also some major weaknesses.	D	7
02	For a performance meeting only the minimum requirements for acceptance.	E	6
00	For a performance which does not meet the minimum requirements for acceptance.	F _x	5 03
-3	For a performance which is unacceptable in all respects.	F	00

Dutch grading system

Ten point grading system

There are many different grading systems in the world, such as (from lowest to highest grade) 1 to 5, 1 to 10, 1 to 20, 1 to 100, 5 to 1, F to A. In Holland a ten point system is used in both secondary and higher education. A grade of 10 is the highest and 6 is the minimum pass grade.

Grade	Meaning
10	Outstanding *
9	Very good *
8	Good
7	More than satisfactory
6	Satisfactory
5	Almost satisfactory
4	Unsatisfactory
3	Very unsatisfactory *
2	Poor *
1*	Very poor *

* The grades 1-3 are hardly ever awarded and 9 and 10 are very rare.

Spanish grading system

In Spain, a ten point system is used in both Secondary and High Education(Bachillerato).

A grade of ten is the highest and five point is the minimum pass grade:

10	Excellent	Extraordinario
9	Very good	Excelente o Muy Bien
8	Very good	Notable
7	Good	Bién
6	Satisfactory	Aceptable
5	Almost satisfactory (the lowest pass mark)	Suficiente
4	Unsatisfactory	Insuficiente
3	Very unsatisfactory	Poco trabajado
2	Poor	Muy pobre
1	Very poor	Muy deficiente
